Academic Achievements

Be Remembered , Be Unique, Be Great , this beautiful words of Dr.A.P.J. Abdul Kalam encompasses the motivation of our school toppers. The SSE and SSCE 2024 saw us achieve remarkable academic excellence with 100 percent results. In SSCE 2024 we presented 40 students out of which 30 of them secured distinction and 10 came with first class. Anjana R emerged the school topper with an aggregate of 96.4%. SSE saw 93 students appearing of whom 73 secured distinction 18 came into first class and 2 in the second class. Meryl Jee George was the school topper with 98 percent.

In the Hindi Sugama Exam Holy Angels’ School was placed 3rd in the account of the largest student body presented. Sruthi. M. Sooraj of std X topped with a 1 st rank, Diya.S of std VIII got the 2 nd rank and Tripti Verma of std VI with the 3 rd rank.
